- Minutes from the January 2017 meeting were reviewed and approved with a motion by Elizabeth Feldwieser and seconded by Shawna Boell.
- Amendments to the Home and School By-Laws were suggested for discussion followed by a vote of those in attendance at our next meeting in March. The Amendment proposal options are as follows:
 - Final approval for the proposed budget for the following year will take place at the May general membership meeting.
 - Any changes to a budgeted line item greater than \$500 per line item (or exceeding \$250 for
 expenditures not included in the approved budget must be approved by the General Board and
 requires a majority vote to pass.
 - Any changes to a budgeted line item \$500 or less (or less than \$250 for expenditures not included in the approved budget may be approved by the Executive Board and requires a majority vote to pass.
- A PayPal account has been established for Home and School fundraising and/or donations by Stephanie Parente.
- An "Opt-out" form for fundraising is being developed to use in conjunction with future fundraisers. The form identifies the option to donate in lieu of participation for those who may be interested.
- A new public Facebook page is being created to allow access to our fundraising information to the public.
 Our current private Facebook page does not allow friends, family and neighbors the ability to access links posted on that page and we may be missing donation opportunities.
 - o In conjunction with this to drive traffic to the new page, the Home and School will be having a contest for the students to submit a logo idea for use on the page. More information will be sent home regarding this as it becomes available.
- Mommy Market volunteers will be needed the evening before to help set up tables.
- We will be hosting a new family night this year on May 19, 2017 at Indian Valley Boys and Girls Club. More details will be sent home as it draws closer.

- The Treasurer's Report ending January 31, 2017 was submitted for review and inclusion in the minutes. It will be available online under our Meeting Minutes heading.
- The current balance is \$35,143.79 as of the closure date listed above.
- \$509.90 was received from BoxTops and we are anticipating an additional check.
- Pretzel sales of \$47 were deposited and the \$375.48 check was deposited from our first Wendy's Night.
- There were some staff appreciation expenditures for the appreciation week in January, some teacher grants were paid and the deposit was submitted for Dad's night.
