### President's Report: Jane Hagan

- Minutes from the April meeting were reviewed and approved with a motion by Kara Derstein and seconded by Val Alburger.
- 2018-2019 elections were held. Bobbi Moyer was elected as vice president with a motion by Lauren Brown & Val Alburger. The vote was unanimous, Bobbi will complete a 2 year term as VP beginning 7/1/18. Maureen Yothers was elected as president with a motion by Shawna Boell & Bobbi Moyer.
- A huge thank you was given to all our volunteers this school year. The teachers donated flower pots filled with sweet treats and thank you cards were made by the students.

### Treasurer's Report: Stephanie Parente

- The budget for the 2018-2019 school year was discussed. The budget was approved with a motion by Shawna Boell & Kara Derstein.
- A Student Scholarship category was added to the budget. Grant money will be awarded to 1-2 students who graduated from Franconia once they graduate from SHS. Details to follow. Extra prize money was added to the Charleston Wrap fundraiser for motivational purposes.
- Expenses: The total for 5<sup>th</sup> grade promotion t-shirts was paid, \$413.07. A miscellaneous expense of \$50 was paid from Mommy Market advertisement. A \$20 park pavilion reservation fee was paid for the summer Book Blast. \$348.40 was paid for Lip Sync Night.
- Revenue: We received \$504 for Wawa Shorti sales. The yearbook deposit was \$2,300.
- The current balance is \$47,037.88.
